## Let's remember the structure of present simple

**+ Affirmative:** For affirmative sentences, we use Subject + verb + complement  
If the subject is (or can be replaced by) He/She/It, add S/ES/IES to the verb

**- Negative:** We add Do Not or Does Not before the verb.

I/you/we/they : Do not

He/she/it : Does not

**? Interrogative:** We use Do or Does at the beginning of the sentence

I/you/we/they : Do

He/she/it : Does

Subject Pronoun	Present Simple Verbs	Examples
<b>I</b>	+ I like ... - I do not like ... ? Do I like ... ? S Yes, I do. No, I do not.	+ I like baseball. - I do not like baseball. ? Do I like baseball?
<b>you</b>	+ You play ... - You do not play ... ? Do you play ... ? S Yes, you do. No, you do not.	+ You play tennis. - You do not play tennis. ? Do you play tennis?
<b>he</b>	+ He studies ... - He does not study ... ? Does he study ... ? S Yes, he does. No, he does not.	+ He studies math. - He does not study math. ? Does he study math?
<b>she</b>	+ She likes ... - She does not like ... ? Does she like ... ? S Yes, she does. No, she does not.	+ She likes cake. - She does not like cake. ? Does she like cake?
<b>it</b>	+ It plays ... - It does not play ... ? Does it play ... ? S Yes, it does. No, it does not.	+ It plays music. - It does not play music. ? Does it play music?
<b>we</b>	+ We study ... - We do not study ... ? Do we study ... ? S Yes, we do. No, we do not.	+ We study science. - We do not study science. ? Do we study science?
<b>you</b>	+ You like ... - You do not like ... ? Do you like ... ? S Yes, you do. No, you do not.	+ You like movies. - You do not like movies. ? Do you like movies?
<b>they</b>	+ They play ... - They do not play ... ? Do they play ... ? S Yes, they do. No, they do not.	+ They play soccer. - They do not play soccer. ? Do they play soccer?
