

**+ Affirmative:** For affirmative sentences, we use Subject + verb + complement If the subject is (or can be replaced by) He/She/It, add S/ES/IES to the verb

- Negative: We add Do Not or Does Not before the verb. I/you/we/they : Do not He/she/it : Does not

? Interrogative: We use Do or Does at the beginning of the sentenceI/you/we/they : DoHe/she/it : Does
